Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for:

Queensland District Board of Management
Division 4 – Casual Vacancy x 1

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Union, may be made at any time from 12pm on **Monday 5 March 2018**. They must reach my office, email mailbox or postal address **not later than 12pm on Monday 23 March 2018**. Nominations cannot be withdrawn after this time.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a biography and/or a statement (“a Candidate’s Statement”) to the Returning Officer in support of their candidature. Statements shall not exceed one A4 single sided page and may include a photo of the candidate. Statements which comply with the requirements of Queensland District Branch Rule 19 and received by 5pm on 2 April 2018 will be distributed by the Returning Officer.

A candidate can only submit one Candidate’s Statement regardless of the number of offices that they are contesting.

A Nomination form is available on application to the Returning Officer, or the District Branch office.

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to herbert@aec.gov.au Senders of emails to the AEC email mailbox be aware that incoming emails that appear to be spam emails may be blocked. Ballots, if required, will be conducted as a postal between Monday 23 April 2018 and Monday 21 May 2018.
